We successfully took Pupil Premium Pupils through the writing moderation process with County—well done all, but especially to Mrs Marsay who was moderated this year.

**Raising Achievement plan 3: Tracking Systems:** The teachers have completed two terms on the new O Track flight path to track pupils. Mrs Mehta has been working hard on looking at KS1 data and establishing end of KS2 targets for the pupils.

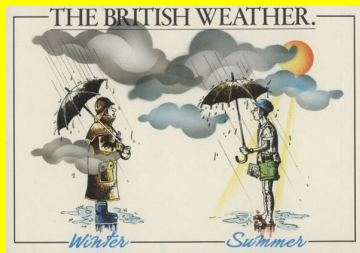


## Life at BLJS
