Raising Achievement plan 2: Disadvantaged pupils: This year the disadvantaged pupils (minus our SEN pupils) managed to reach the expected standard in Writing, Maths and GPAS. We successfully took Pupil Premium Pupils through the writing moderation process with County—well done all, but especially to Mrs Marsay who was moderated this year.

Raising Achievement plan 3: Tracking Systems: The teachers have completed two terms on the new O Track flight path to track pupils. Mrs Mehta has been working hard on looking at KS1 data and establishing end of KS2 targets for the pupils.
